“絆の絵 Kizuna = Ties of Friendship” featuring drawings by thirty surviving Japanese children from Northeast Japan. The children come from areas worst affected by the Great East Japan Earthquake in March 2011.

The Kizuna drawings project was initiated by the organization “Global Festa Japan 2011,” and the themes for the children's drawings are: “To all of you around the world, thank you,” “Myself in 10 years,” and “What I want to do.” Despite the traumas the children have been through, their pictures reveal optimism and dreams for the future.

The exhibition is organized in collaboration with the Embassy of Japan, and lasts from **May 13 until August 13, 2012. WELCOME!**
